Belgic Confession: Article 14, Canons of Dort: 1-2

We believe that God created man out of the dust of the earth, and made and formed him after his own image and likeness, good, righteous, and holy, capable in all things to will, agreeably to the will of God. But [mankind] willfully subjected himself to sin, and consequently to death, and the curse, giving ear to the words of the devil.
